RULES

Exhibitors submitting entries are asked to read and abide by the rules as listed below. These rules will be strictly adhered to.

ENTRIES

- All entries must be made on official entry form, either on paper, or online, which must be completed in full.
- No entry will be accepted without correct entry fees.
- All entries must be registered with their respective Breed Societies unless otherwise stated

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving reasons for doing so.

CLOSING DATE - Entries close on **FRIDAY 26TH MAY 2023** for ALL CLASSES.

NB: Due to printing of catalogues NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted.

CANCELLATION - The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide any class or classes.

JUDGING/JUDGES - The decision of the Judges is final. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the Judges' Panel if it should become necessary.

APPEAL - Any exhibitor wishing to appeal must do so in writing and lodge his appeal together with a deposit of £20, with the Secretary before the closure of the Show. In the event of the appeal being dismissed, the deposit will be forfeited.

BARREN MARE - When entering Barren Mare classes the following definition should be noted:- Barren Mare must not have produced and will not produce a foal in the current year.

BROOD MARE - When entering Brood Mare classes the following definition should be noted: Brood mares must be 4 years old or over with foal at foot or have produced a foal in the current year. Brood mares must always be accompanied by their own foal, or a veterinary certificate must be produced to justify the absence of the foal.

W.P.C.S. MEDALS - Medals will be awarded subject to the conditions of the Society.

BEHAVIOUR - Any act of ill treatment or discourteous behaviour whatsoever may result in the offender being reported to his respective Society and any prize money being withheld.

HORSE BOXES/TRAILERS - Anyone found mucking out horse boxes/trailers or leaving litter on the Showground will be fined £100 this includes lorry waste.

COUGHING - Any horse or pony persistently coughing will be pronounced unsound and asked to leave the showground.

DOGS - All dogs must be kept on leads at all times on the show field.

HARD HATS - Hard hats must be worn at all times when riding ponies and horses. NPS Rules apply for all ridden classes.

INTERPRETATION - The interpretation of these and any other rules or conditions, written or implied, rests with the Organisers. All entries are accepted on the assumption that exhibitors have read these rules.

DISCLAIMER - The Organisers accept no liability for loss, damage or injury, personal or otherwise, howsoever caused.

TIMETABLE - Every effort has been made to accommodate classes, but this is the responsibility of the exhibitor to decide which classes to enter should any classes clash. DO NOT ask for any classes to be delayed. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure that they are in the ring at the correct time and the organisers cannot be responsible for missed classes.

Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.

POLICY STATEMENT

The Severn Valley Welsh Pony and Cob Association accepts its responsibility for providing and maintaining so far as is reasonably practicable, at all times during the setting up and running of Severn Valley Show, an environment which is both safe and healthy for all.

To this end, The Severn Valley Welsh Pony and Cob Association will take all steps within its power to meet its responsibilities under the Health and Safety Act 1974 and all other legal requirements for Health and Safety, and actively seeks the full and understanding co-operation of all persons involved in the Show for their commitment to the same.

No exhibitor will be accepted without adequate public liability insurance.

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st – 3rd August 2023

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

Classes 69 onwards that are run as mixed breed classes: NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st – 3rd August 2023

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.
